- Explain how to move an asset through its entire life cycle.
- Configure search through assets using facets.
- Configure DAM asset metadata to establish relationships between entities.
- Configure components in the Content Hub Asset Detail page to display relevant metadata.
- Configure user security settings and permissions.
- Implement triggers that respond to state changes using the Script, Action, and Trigger frameworks.
