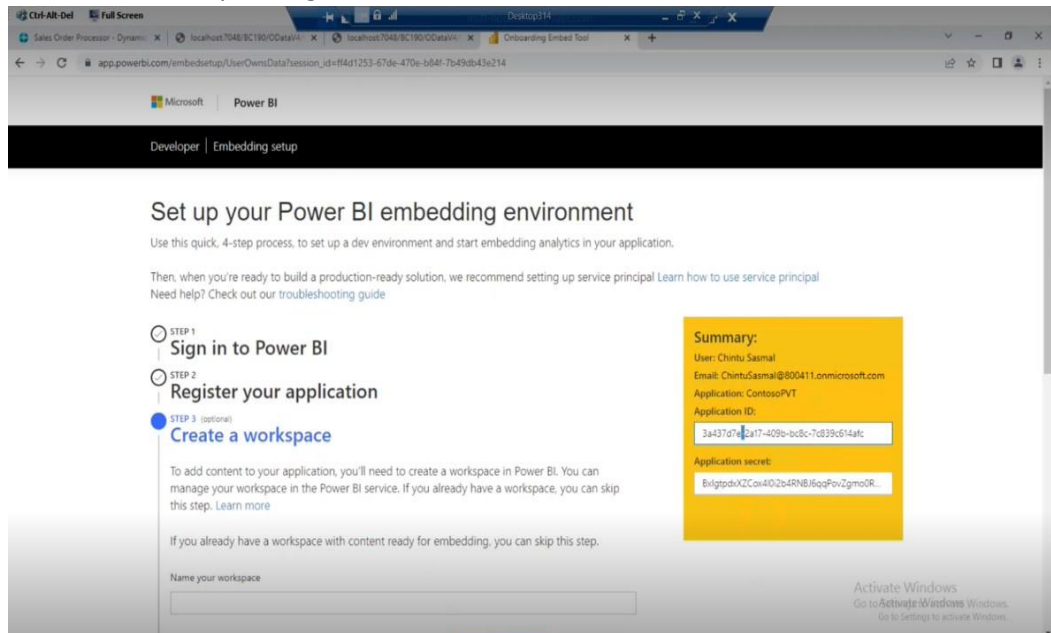
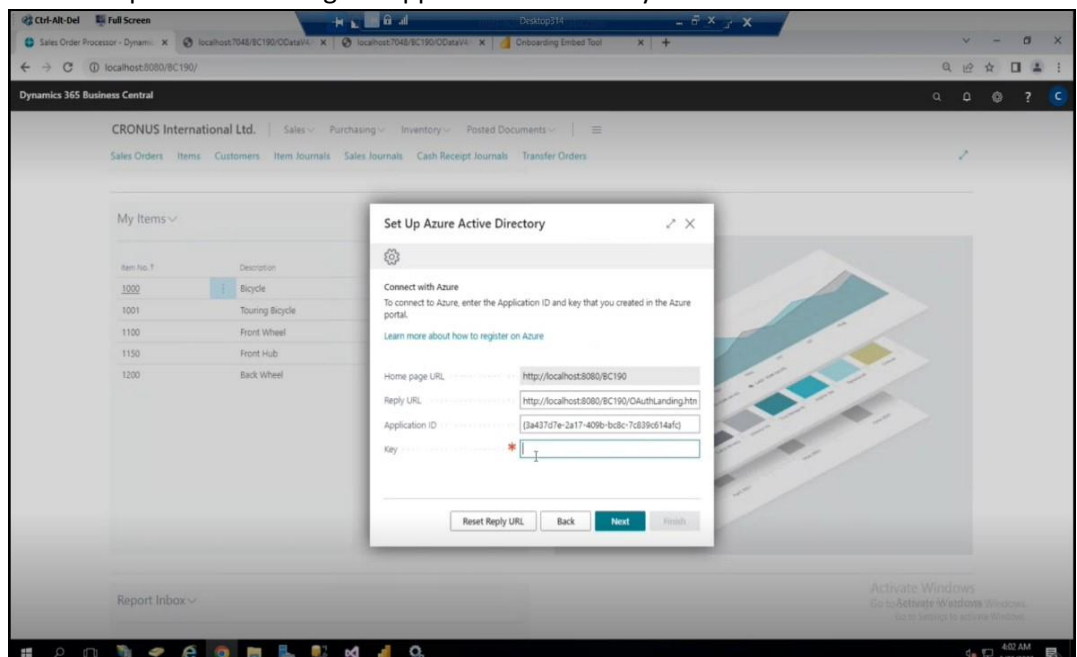


How to connect Business Central to Power BI

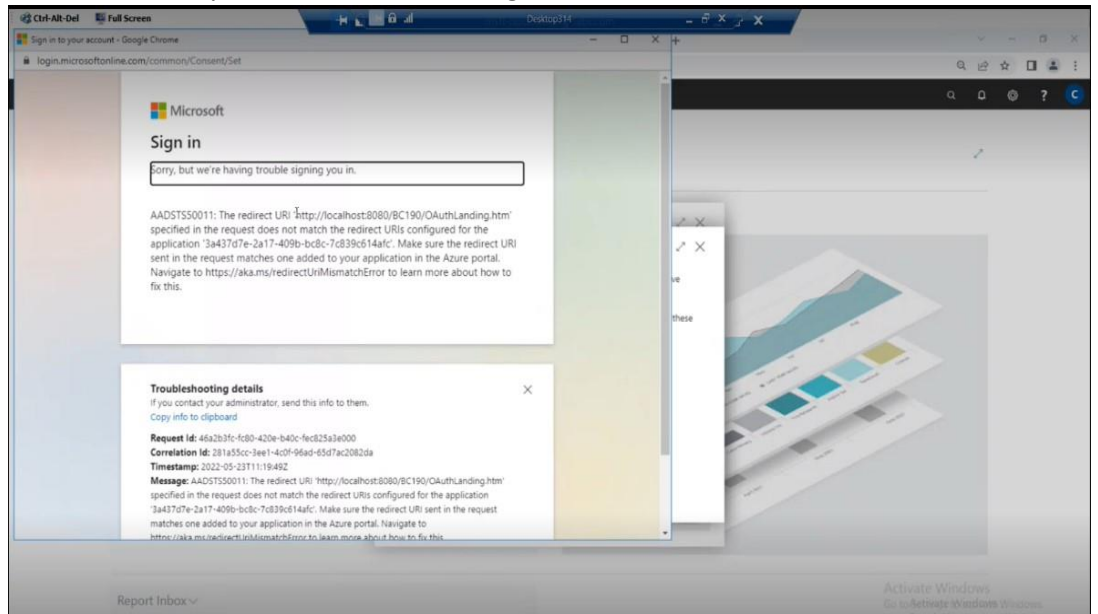
- Visit <https://app.powerbi.com/embedsetup>

- Select Embed for your organisation



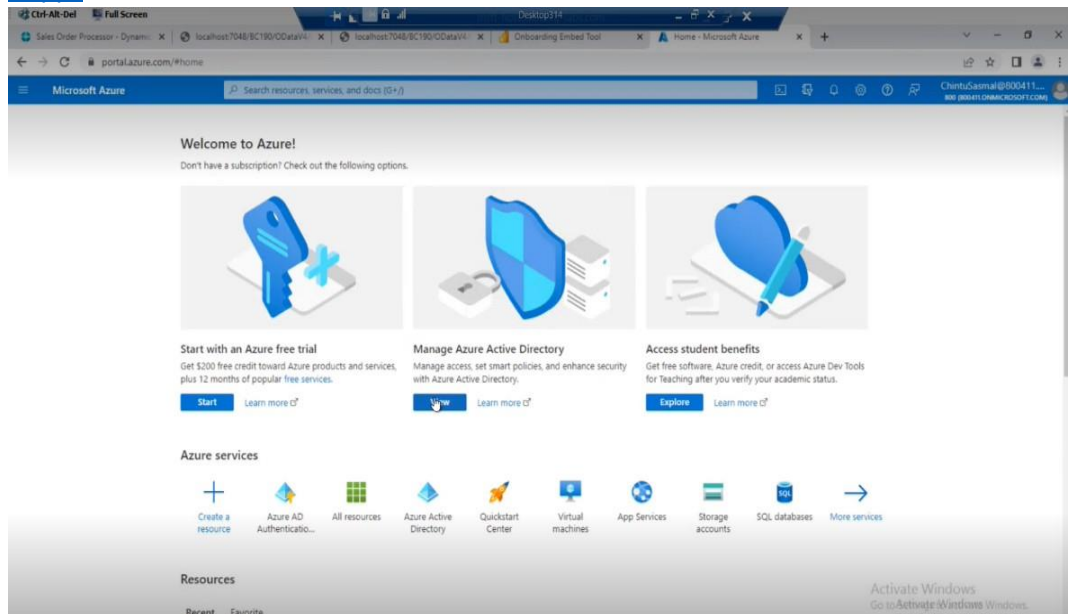
- Sign in and generate Application ID and Key
- In Business Central setup the power bi
- Click next panel until asking for Application ID and Key



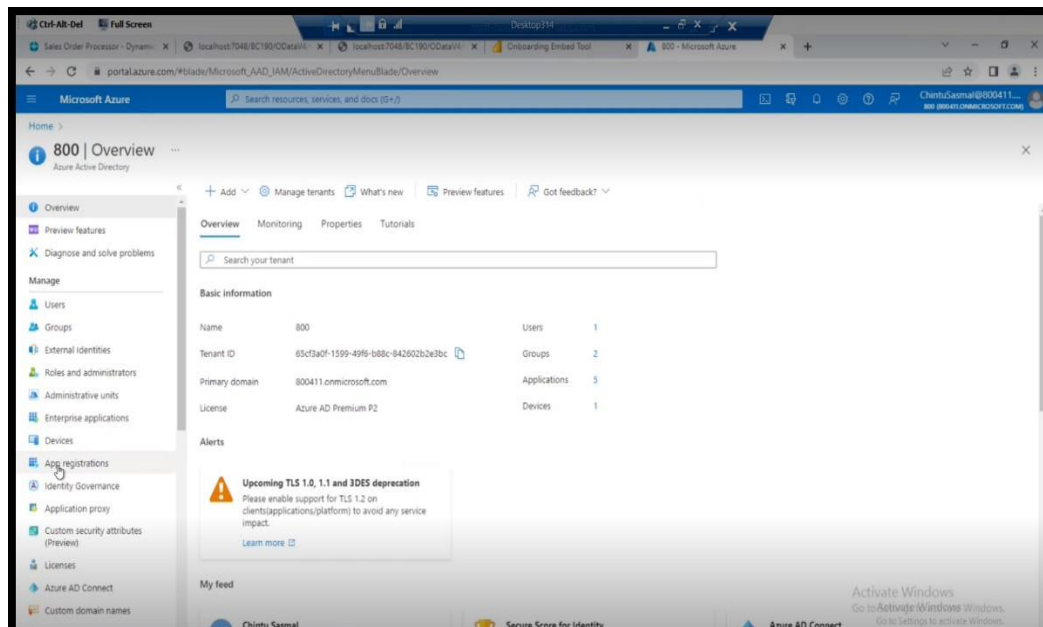
- Fill the ID and Key in Business central navigation tool.



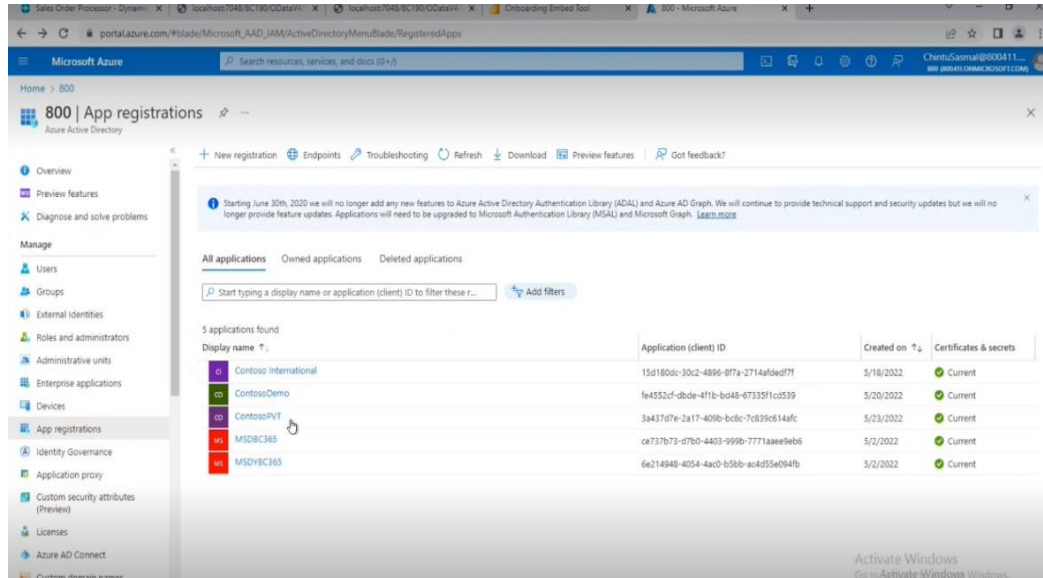
- If you face login and redirect url issue follow below steps.

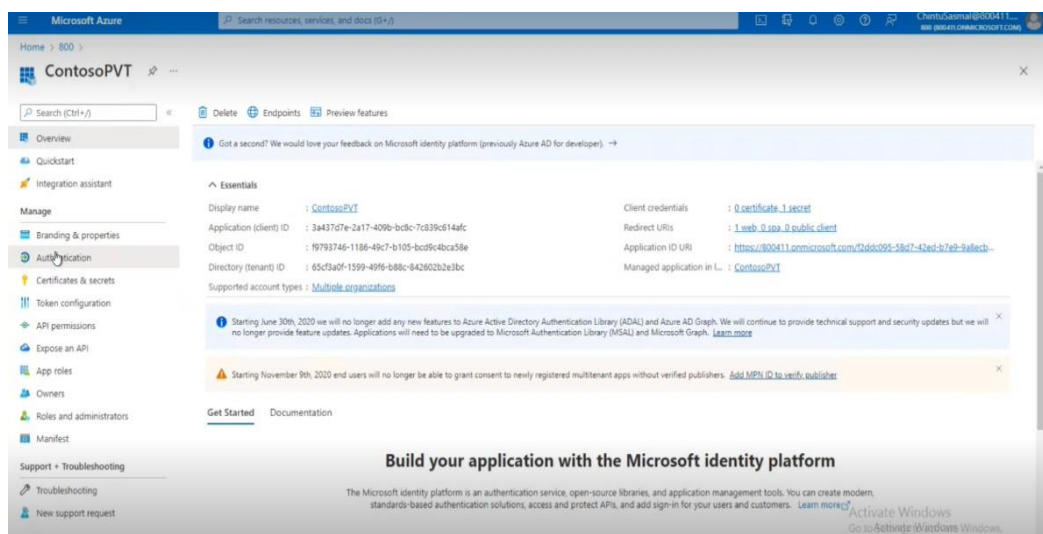
- Visit above page and Click on App registrations from the lefthand side of the column

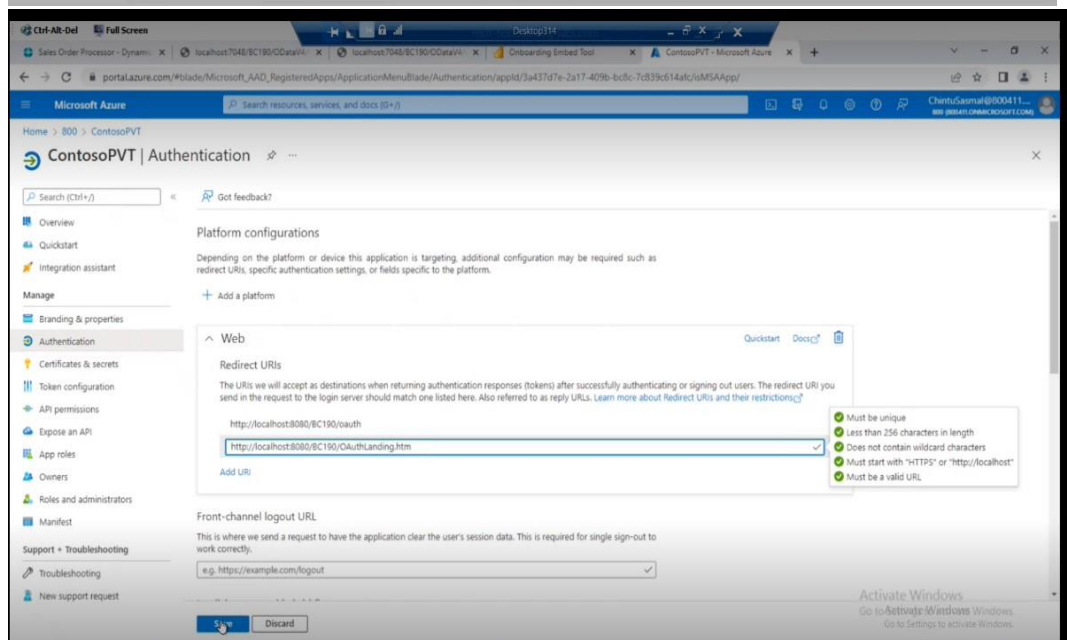
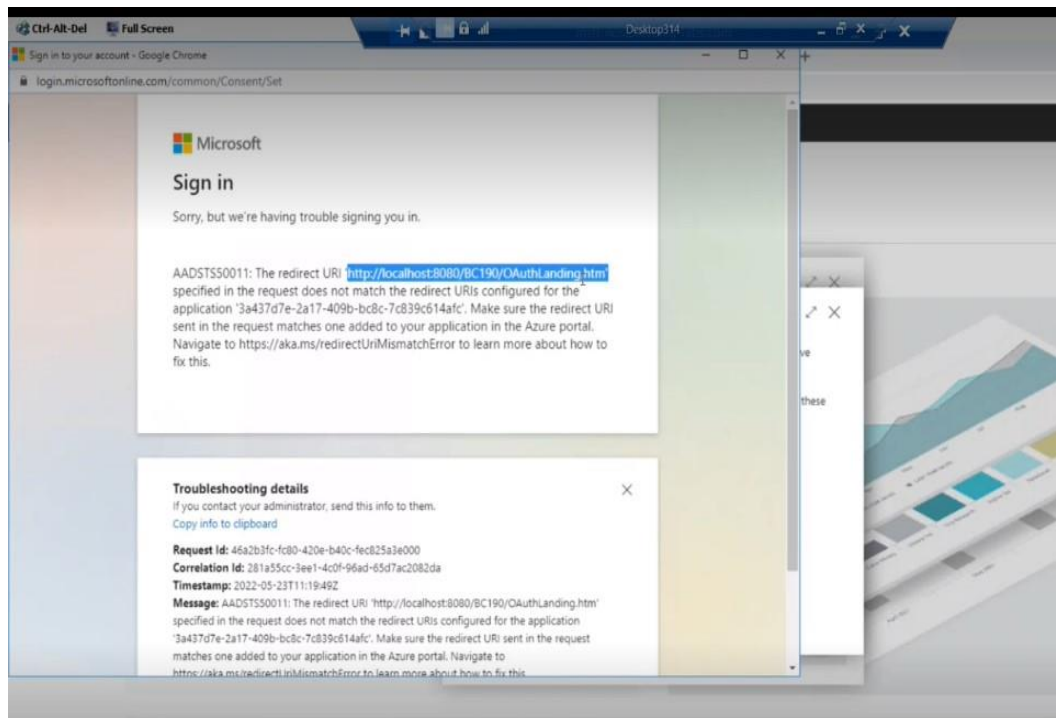


- Select the name of the Application you have provided and saved at the start of registration.




- Then click on Authentication panel and Add the url which it was getting redirected to.
